

Aspirin and Ibuprofen Caution Sheet for Surgery Patients

For 14 days prior to surgery and 10 days after surgery, do not take any Medication containing aspirin, ibuprofen, or other non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAIDs). Please refer to the list below for those medications that contain aspirin and /or ibuprofen. If it is necessary for you to take any medication, please use Tylenol or acetaminophen substitutes.
